- Check lighting and room temperature (adjust as necessary)
- Place out speaker tent card(s)
- Ensure the podium has water
- Introduce the session speaker and read brief bio
- Monitor microphone sound, if any feedback track down/notify the AV tech
- Take headcount mid-session
- Work the Q&A microphones in the room
- Monitor time and visually signal the speaker if he/she is running behind
- Close out the session, thank the speakers and announce any housekeeping items
- After the session:
 - i. Remove speaker tent card(s)
 - ii. Make sure that the hotel is refreshing the room and head table

- Provide directions to the sessions/events
- Help place out signage
